



## What is VTrans?

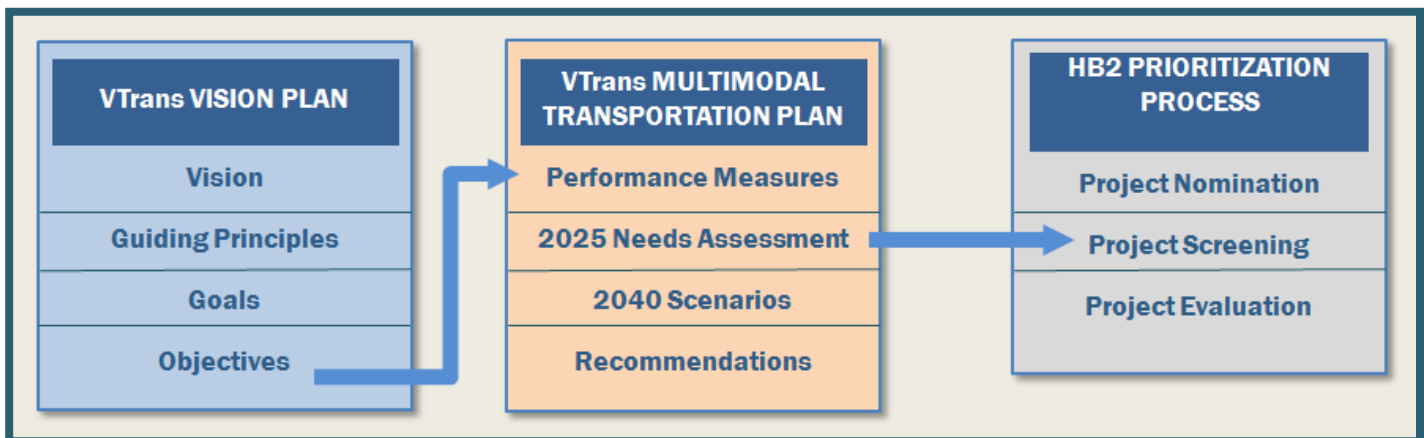
VTrans is the long-range, statewide multimodal policy plan that lays out overarching Vision and Goals for transportation in the Commonwealth. It identifies transportation priorities and provides direction to transportation agencies on strategies and programs to be incorporated into their plans and programs. The plan is being developed in two phases and will result in the production of two companion documents: the VTrans2040 Vision and the VTrans2040 Multimodal Transportation Plan.

## What is the Status of VTrans2040?

The [VTrans2040 Vision](#) document is being drafted at this time and will be available for review in the near future at [www.vtrans.org](http://www.vtrans.org). The draft plan will be presented to the Commonwealth Transportation Board in March/April of 2015. The [VTrans2040 Multimodal Transportation Plan](#) (VMTP, formerly the VSTP) is in the scoping phases and will be kicked-off soon as well.

## How do the VTrans2040 and the HB2 Processes Integrate?

Moving forward, only projects that help address a need identified in the VTrans2040 Multimodal Transportation Plan will be considered for funding under the statewide prioritization process from House Bill 2. The plan will focus on the needs of the Commonwealth's statewide network of Corridors of Statewide Significance, the multimodal regional networks that support travel within metropolitan regions, and improvements to promote locally designated Urban Development Areas (UDAs).



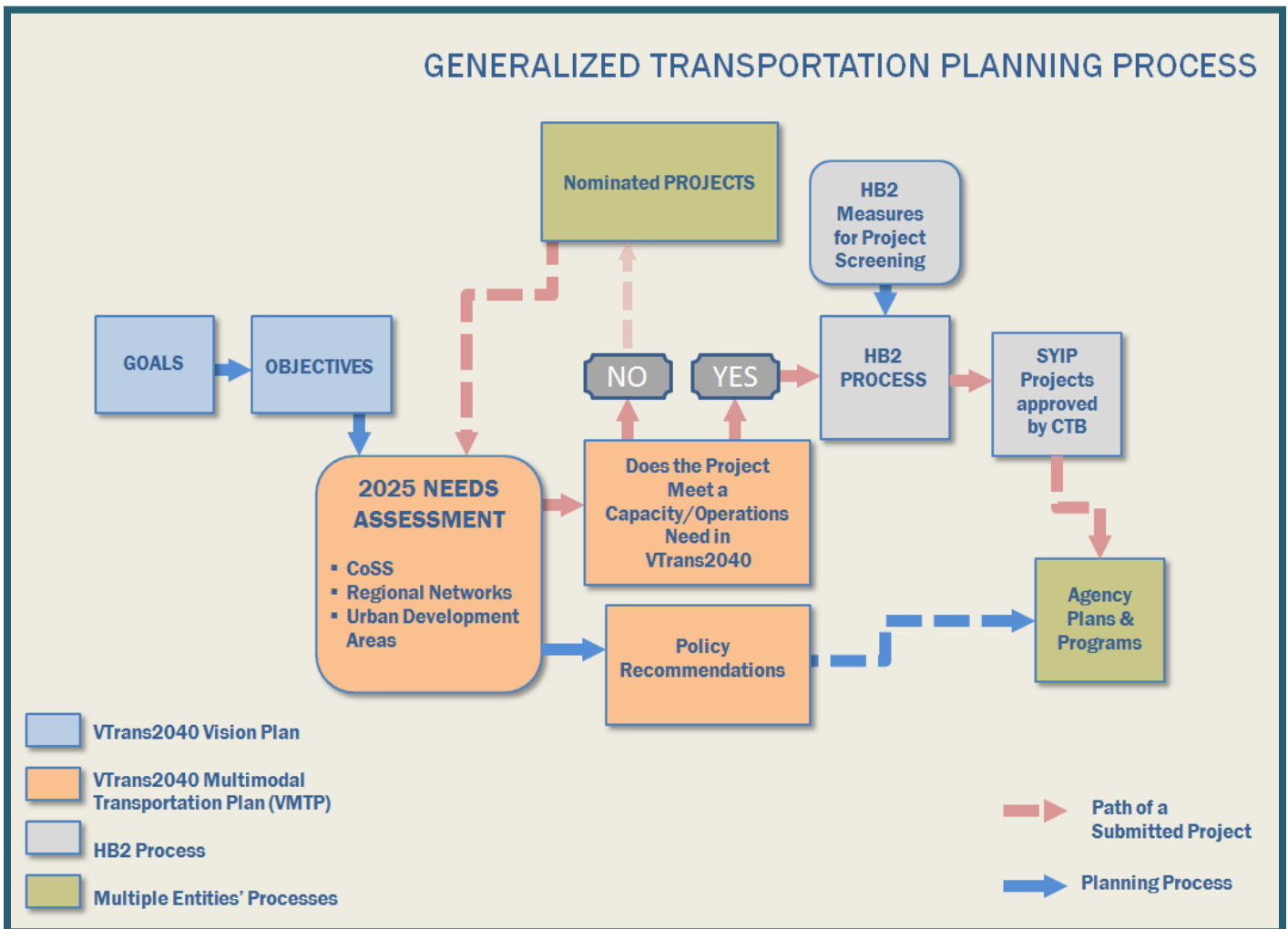
## How Does A Project Get In the VTrans2040 Multimodal Transportation Plan (VMTP) Needs Assessment?
